

Polityka Cookies

1. The Service does not automatically collect any information, except for information contained in cookies.
2. Cookies (so-called “cookies”) are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored on the end device of the Service User and are intended for use with the Service’s websites. Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which they originate, the time they are stored on the end device, and a unique number.
3. The entity placing cookies on the Service User’s end device and obtaining access to them is the website owner – **VarsoviaFX LTD** – contact details are available in the “Contact” section.
4. Cookies may be used for the following purposes:
 - a. adjusting the content of the Service’s websites to the User’s preferences and optimizing the use of websites; in particular, these cookies allow the Service to recognize the User’s device and properly display the website, tailored to individual needs;
 - b. creating statistics that help understand how Users use the Service’s websites, which enables improvement of their structure and content;
 - c. maintaining the Service User’s session (after logging in), thanks to which the User does not have to re-enter their login and password on each subpage of the Service.
5. Two basic types of cookies are used within the Service: “session cookies” and “persistent cookies.”

“Session cookies” are temporary files that are stored on the User’s end device until logging out, leaving the website, or closing the software (web browser).

“Persistent cookies” are stored on the User’s end device for the time specified in the cookie parameters or until they are deleted by the User.
6. The following types of cookies may be used within the Service:
 - a. “necessary” cookies, enabling the use of services available within the Service, e.g. authentication cookies used for services requiring authentication within the Service;
 - b. cookies used to ensure security, e.g. those used to detect abuses in authentication within the Service;
 - c. “performance” cookies, enabling the collection of information on how the Service’s websites are used;
 - d. “functional” cookies, enabling the Service to “remember” User-selected settings and personalize the User interface, e.g. with regard to selected language or region, font size, website appearance, etc.;
 - e. “advertising” cookies, enabling delivery of advertising content more tailored to Users’ interests.
7. In many cases, software used for browsing websites (web browsers) allows cookies to be stored on the User’s end device by default. Service Users may change their cookie settings at any time. These settings can be changed in particular to block automatic handling of cookies in the web browser settings or to inform the User each time cookies are placed on their device. Detailed information on the possibilities and methods of handling cookies is available in the software (web browser) settings.
8. The Service Operator informs that restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some functionalities available on the Service’s websites.
9. Cookies placed on the User’s end device and used may also be used by advertisers and partners cooperating with the Service Operator.
